

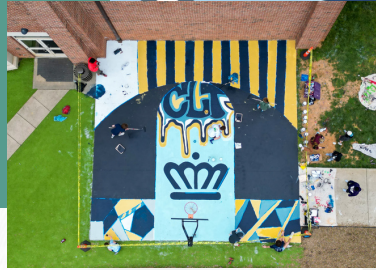
MURAL WORKSHOP

WHAT TO EXPECT

-Generation WE provides everything for the workshop, including paint supplies, professional muralist, and a book of choice for each child.

- *The students are asked to chose a book from our collection to take home. Our goal is for each child to find a book where they see themselves represented in some way, or that they find one that inspires them to learn about others.*

-Students spend time sharing about personal stories, hopes, fears and inspirations, then come together with the muralist to create a mural design for either a wall or ground covering.

-Students work with the muralist to prep, paint and seal the mural.

- Workshop requires a minimum of 10+ hours (depending on scope and size of mural).

-Target age range is 10-15 years old.

This is a wonderful workshop for schools and organizations that want to host a permanent reminder of their beautifully unique and diverse student body.
